The Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) does not provide detailed information on responsive projects proposals under consideration. Once the Contribution Agreement is signed, relevant information is posted on CIDA's website in accordance with the requirements of the Proactive Disclosure Policy.

Canada's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Strategy for the Canadian International Extractive Sector acknowledges that "close cooperation with stakeholders is, therefore, required for the successful implementation of the Building the Canadian Advantage Strategy." This collaboration extends to the implementation of CIDA's obligations under the Strategy in the realm of host country capacity building.

In the CSR project proposals received by CIDA's Partnerships with Canadians Branch to date, NGOs and firms have described arrangements of shared leadership and responsibility, with strong engagement in project design, implementation, and evaluation on the part of local communities. Projects being considered by CIDA would support the strengthening of alliances and partnerships that increase the impact, quality and sustainability of development activities.

CIDA would not become involved in the operations of particular initiatives, but would require any approved projects to be designed and implemented in conformity with all applicable CIDA policies, including resultsbased management. The Partnerships with Canadians Branch would require financial contributions from the Canadian NGO, and would monitor these projects by means of regular reporting, including a full accounting of expenditures by the NGO.

The Official Development Assistance Accountability Act (ODAAA) requires that for international assistance to be reported as Official Development Assistance (ODA) it must: contribute to poverty reduction, take in the perspectives of the poor, and be consistent with international human rights standards. Poverty reduction has been at the core of CIDA's mandate for many years. The assistance provided by CIDA contributes to poverty reduction in developing countries in an effective and focused manner. CIDA takes the perspectives of the poor into account as a central element in delivering Canada's aid program, for instance through consultations with local partners and beneficiaries, participatory approaches and policy dialogue. CIDA's programs are consistent with international human rights standards.

CIDA has integrated the provisions of the ODAAA in its policies and programs. They are part of CIDA's project assessment process via policy and programming documents that require a thorough analysis of the development context in relation with the ODAAA's requirements. Policy guidance is provided to staff to ensure that funding decisions take into account the relevant provisions of the ODAAA.
